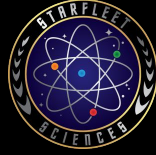

“Faster, cleaner and warp-free”



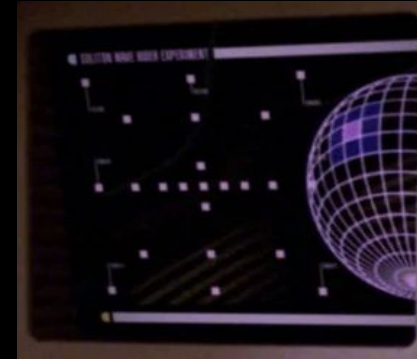


Soliton Wave

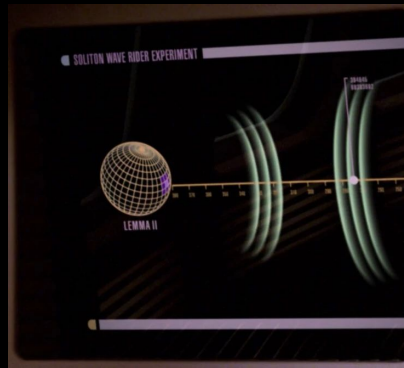
- A form of propulsion that creates coherent energy pulses that maintain shape and velocity across long distances
- First tested by Doctor Ja'Dar at Bilana III.
- Field tested by Doctor Belor & Doctor Rejal at Bajoran wormhole.
- Warp field is no longer needed, the ship rides in principle the wave.
- Dilithium is no longer required.
- Warp core stress is no longer an issue.
- It has minimal impact on subspace.



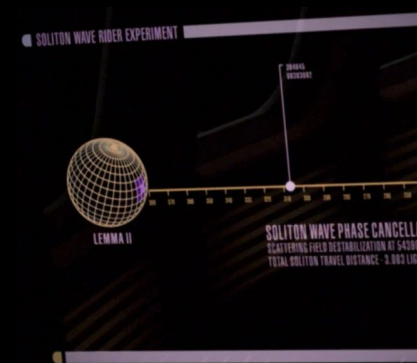
1) Field coils activated

Why it stayed a theory

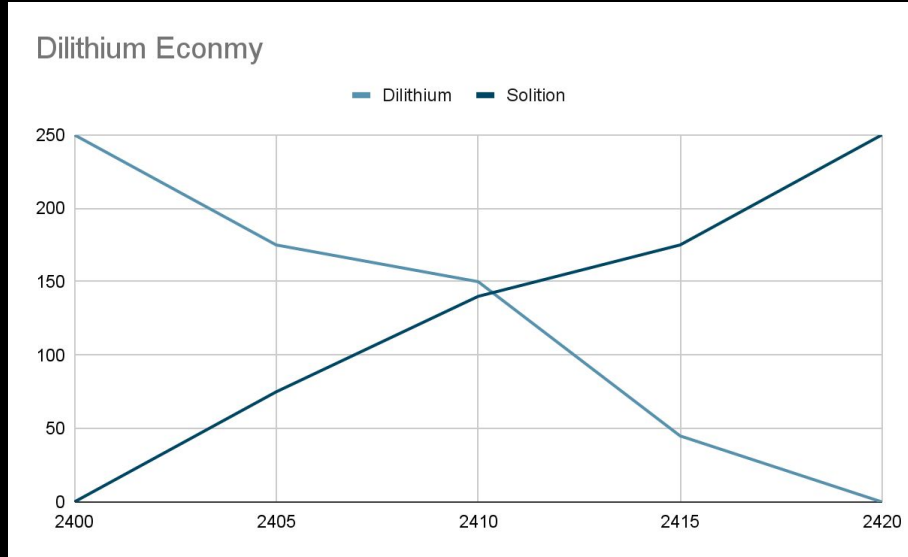
- Field test in 2368, with attendee USS Enterprise-D. Was deemed an almost a disaster due to an unexpected destabilization in the wave that further manifested a subspace distortion. This was stopped by the USS Enterprise-D.
- Starfleet Science division immediately shelved the project after the incident at Bilana III.
- The project was never revisited.





The Truth

- The galaxy spins around a dilithium-dependent economy.
 - Soliton Drive is a **threat**.
- Warp cores would become obsolete within 20-years.
- The Bilana III incident is marked by sabotage.
 - Telemetry of the incident was "lost" during the subspace event.
 - There is feedback of energy spike logged in external sensors.





Best Hope

- Best for environmental neutral propulsion.
- Can be used for all kind of travel
 - Transportation, exploration, and defense.
- Resilient to warp shutdowns and subspace instability.
- Course correction possible due to new micro-resonance emitters.
